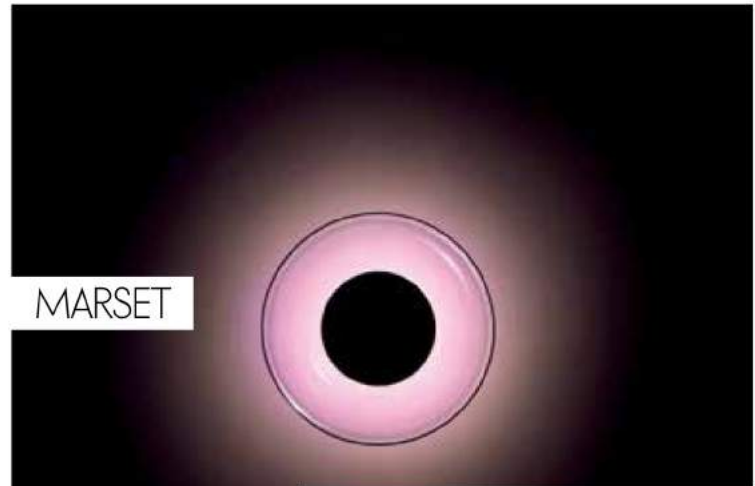

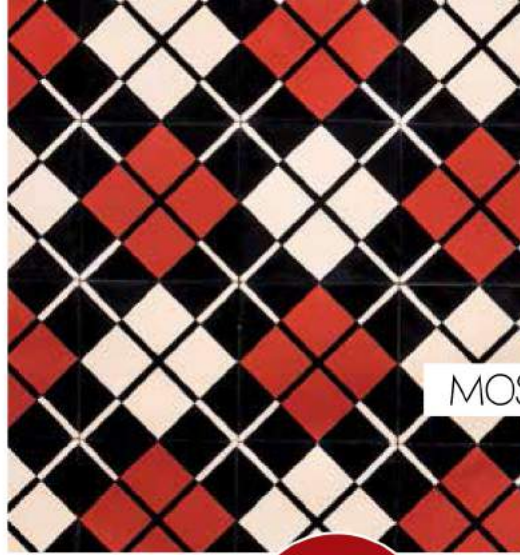

Solomillo: Merely a 5 minute walk from Gaudi's popular structures in the city, the gastronomy section of Alexandra DoubleTree Hotel by Hilton Barcelona greets you with its industrial decor designed by the local studio Barrell Jover Arquitectos. Almost all elements here are from native labels. For instance, the Funiculi lamps by Marset were designed by Lluís Porqueras in 1979 while the Basica Minima lamps by Santa & Cole are from 1989.
