6 High Line

Sleek and sculptural, this floor lamp reflects light off the wall, rather than the ceiling, and pairs a natural wood column with a colourful lacquered base.

7 Guise

This tubular lamp uses total internal reflection to capture light in subtle etchings on the surface of the glass. The series comprises vertical and horizontal interpretations, as well as a wall version.
